1. The counsel for the State submits that provisional admission has been released to the petitioner, as directed by this court.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 5 states that a notice of disaffiliation has been issued to the petitioner on 8th December, 2014. Any admission taken by the students pursuant to the order already issued will abide by the final result of the notice and the rights will be protected only in the manner that regulation expressly provide for. If the petitioner comes by any adverse order on the basis of the notice now issued by the 5th respondent, the petitioner will have independent remedy through a writ

petition at appropriate stage. Copy of the letter issued to the Principal by the Additional Director, Industrial Training Department directing provisional admission is taken on record.

3. The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
