The petitioner has approached this Court by challenging the award dated 17.1.2013 (Annexure P-3), whereby the services of the petitioner were terminated while working as a Science Guest Teacher.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion, granted interim relief to the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel has informed the Court that in view of the status report filed in Civil Writ Petition No.2968 of 2015, the services of the petitioner have been terminated vide order dated 9.2.2015 on the ground that he is overage and retired on 30.4.2005 (without any special certificate/state award). Photocopy of the order is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one by challenging the order in case of any grievance.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is permitted to be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforementioned.
