The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of writ of prohibition restraining the respondents from withholding the consignments of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, order of provisional release has been passed. It was urged that certain conditions have been imposed therein which are contrary to the various pronouncements of this Court. He prayed that in the light of the abovesaid provisional order having been passed, the present petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such. However, liberty may be granted to the petitioner to challenge the order of provisional release.

3. Disposed of as infructuous. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to challenge order of provisional release, in accordance with law.
