In this writ petition filed in public interest, a prayer has been made that a direction be issued to the respondents to preserve the double-storeyed building situated in Mohalla Shahganj, Turi Bazar, Ferozepur, which remained as the office of Shaheed Bhagat Singh and other revolutionaries during the year 1928-29 as monument under 'The Punjab Ancient and Historical Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1964' (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act').

In para 3 of the written statement filed on behalf of respondent

No.1, it has been stated that on consideration of the issue, the said building has been declared as protected monument under the Act. In this regard, notification dated 22.12.2014 has already been issued, copy of which has been annexed with the written statement as Annexure R-1/2.

In view of the said steps taken by respondent No.1, the petitioner states that he does not want to press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
