The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition for quashing of the qualification prescribed for the post of PGT Political Science in Column 3(i) of Appendix-B under Rule 7 of the Haryana State Education School Cadre (Group B) Service Rule, 2012 which were notified on 11.4.2012 (Annexure-P-9) as it prescribed only MA Political Science with 50% marks and B.Ed to be eligible for the post of Political Science and to treat them, who are having degree of M.A. in Public Administration with 50% marks and B.Ed, as eligible for recruitment to the post of Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) in Political Science.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State while placing on record a communication received from The Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector-5, Panchkula, stated that Government has decided to refer this matter to a committee which has already been constituted consisting of Head of Departments of Political Science and Public Administration of both the Universities i.e. Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak, under the chairmanship of Director Secondary Education, Haryana and in that meeting the decision will be taken whether a candidate possessing the MA Public Administration with 50% marks be held to be eligible for the above mentioned post or not. He has further stated that at present no recruitment is under process.

In view of the said submissions, we dispose of this writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to make a representation stating new facts, if any in addition to the averments made in the present petition before the said Committee. If any such representation is filed, the Committee is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law and take the decision in this regard by passing a speaking order.
