Notice of motion.

On our asking, Ms. Kirti Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on their behalf. There is no necessity to seek reply of the respondents keeping in view the nature of order which we propose to pass.

The short grievance of the petitioners is against deletion of their names from the Voters' List of Village Nangal Kheri, District Panipat.

Since the petitioners have placed on record sufficient documentary evidence to substantiate their claim that they are *bona-fide* residents of their village, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction that let the appeal already filed by the petitioners under the Statute, as is clear from the communication dated 24.08.2015 [P-6] be heard and decided by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Election Officer, Panipat in accordance with law and keeping in view the documents relied upon by them. Let appropriate orders be passed thereon before Gram Panchayat elections are held.
