The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the order dated 27.08.2015 (Annexure P-8) passed by the Registrar General of Societies, Haryana.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 4 to 6 states that during pendency of the writ petition, appeal has been decided by the Registrar vide order dated 09.10.2015. Since instant writ petition has been filed against the interim order, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner alleges that the election process was stayed in midway. The term of the Committee has already expired on 07.10.2015.

Be that as it may, the fact remains that even if there is no committee, the election is required to be held in accordance with law. The Registrar General of Societies, Haryana is directed to complete the entire process including preparation, verification of lists of members etc. and hold election within six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Disposed of in above terms.
