In pursuance of order dated 07.10.2015, parties are present in Court and state that they have compromised the matter. Respondent No.3 states that she has received the possession of the premises in question from the petitioners. The petitioners also state that they have vacated the premises in question and possession of the same has been handed over to respondent No.3. They will not interfere in her possession in future. They, however, state that they have a right to visit

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their children who are living with respondent No.3. Separate statements of the petitioners and respondent no.3 have been recorded in Court.
