1. *Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment ?*

SURYA KANT, J. (ORAL)

Mr. Sharma, learned counsel for the official respondents states that the respondent-Authorities have no objection in considering the petitioner's claim for promotion w.e.f. 13.03.2000 i.e. the date when she became eligible, for which the petitioner is required to submit a Self Appraisal Form along with requisite documents etc. Learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection against submission of the Form or the relevant information without prejudice to her legal rights.

Since the respondents have come up with a fair stand as

conveyed by them through written instructions given to their learned counsel, a copy whereof has been placed on record also, we dispose of this writ petition at this stage with a direction to the respondents to expedite the process of consideration of the petitioner's claim for promotion and do the needful at the earliest but not beyond the period of three months from the date of deposit of Self Appraisal Form by the petitioner.

We also grant liberty to the petitioner to seek revival of these proceedings, and/or initiate fresh proceedings, if need be.

Ordered accordingly.
