The impugned orders dated 27.06.2014 (P-10A to P-10C) are revisable by the State Government under Section 42 of the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets Act, 1961.

As the above-stated statutory alternative remedy is equally efficacious, we relegate the petitioners to avail such a remedy. In case the revision petition is filed by the petitioners within one month from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order, learned counsel for the respondent-Board fairly states that no objection regarding limitation shall be taken.

We direct the Revisional Authority to decide the revision petition on merits and in accordance with law as early as possible and preferably within a period of four months from the date of its filing.

Ordered accordingly.
