TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA J. (ORAL)

The instant writ petition is directed against the award dated 13.10.2011 passed by the Labour Court, Ambala at Annexure P-3, in terms of which, workman/respondent No.1 was granted the relief of reinstatement of service in continuity and full back wages.

Counsel appearing for the parties are ad idem that the workman has been employed elsewhere i.e. has been appointed as Conductor under Haryana Roadways and to such extent would not be even contesting such petition insofar as the relief of reinstatement is concerned.

Mr. D. S. Nalwa, Advocate for respondent No.1 and learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-college would submit that even with regard to the back wages, an application filed by the workman claiming back wages as a consequence of the impugned award has already been allowed and furthermore, even CWP No.26069 of 2013

filed in this Court by the petitioner-college against the order dated

22.08.2013 passed by the Labour Court allowing the application under Section 33-C(2) of the ID Act has been dismissed on 28.11.2013.

In the light of such uncontroverted factual position, nothing would survive in the instant writ petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.
