The petitioner seeks the relief of release of retrial benefits
which have allegedly been withheld by the respondents on account of
pendency of the charge-sheet dated 12.03.2012.

On 22.09.2015, the following order was passed by this
Court:

*"The retiral benefits of the petitioner has been
withheld, in view of the chargesheet dated 12.02.2012
(Annexure P-6 colly).*

*Counsel for the State prays for time to find out the
status of the case and whether any Enquiry Officer was
appointed to look into the allegations levelled in the
chargesheet.*

*If not, the retiral dues of the petitioner will be paid
within a period of four weeks, thereafter.*

Adjourned to 04.11.2015."

Vide present affidavit, which has been filed today, it has been deposed that vide letter dated 17.11.2014, the inquiry against the petitioner has been filed. He has been given warning under Punjab Civil Services Rule 1970 (Minor Punishment). The pension benefits have been given.

In view of the reply filed, it is apparent that the writ petition has become infructuous and is disposed of as such.
