Written statement filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 filed in Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State has gone on record to submit that there is no compulsion for production of Aadhar Card or enrollment number for obtaining the benefits under public distribution system, but, only one identification proof was required. The said statement is recorded and the circular issued by the Government of Haryana under Annexure-P3 will be understood as not constituting any compulsion for any member of the public to submit the Aadhar Card to claim the benefits through any of the public distribution system, provided, however, any other form of identity proof as required, is tendered to the authorities.

With these observations, writ petition is disposed of.
