Prayer in this petition is to restrain the State of Punjab and its functionaries, i.e. respondents No.2 and 3, as well as Gram Panchayat, Village Bhadal Thua, Tehsil Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab from constructing a veterinary hospital on the disputed land which has been developed as a cremation ground by the petitioners.

Counsel for the State of Punjab submits that vide decision dated 30.03.2015, the State Government has decided not to construct a veterinary hospital on the land offered by the Gram Panchayat as a new site has been selected and approved.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not want to press the present petition.

In view of statement made by counsel for the parties, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
