Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in respect of the relief claimed in this petition, i.e. counting of service rendered on daily wages, followed by regularization, for the purpose of retiral benefits, a legal notice is stated to have been served on behalf of the petitioners, upon the respondents, on 8.1.2014, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

He submits that, at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents, to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice within a specified period, taking into consideration the fact that the respondents have also issued instructions with regard to the grant of benefit of service rendered in a temporary capacity, prior to regularization of an employee, for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents, to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice, by passing a speaking order, within a period of two

months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, keeping in view the instructions issued by the respondent department itself, as also the judgment on the subject, as referred to in the legal notice.

In case the relief sought in this petition, or any part thereof, is found due, the same shall be released to the petitioners within a period of two months thereafter.

If, for any legally valid reasons, the relief sought by the petitioners, or any part thereof, is not found due, detailed reasons for the same shall be given in the speaking order to be passed.
