This case was listed before this Court yesterday in which notice was issued for today keeping in view the urgency involved.

The respondents have filed their reply. Satwant Singh, SDM, Kapurthala and Narender Kumar, SHO, Police Station Fattu Dyinga, District Kapurthala are present in Court. There is no doubt that Chinj Mela (wrestling competition) is in progress at the venue but the only issue involved is about the use of loudspeaker by the petitioners which has been denied by the SDM, Kapurthala vide his order dated 11.9.2015. The SDM has explained to the Court that the Patth of Gurbani is being held in

the vicinity of the Chinj Mela, therefore, use of loudspeaker may hamper the said patth.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they would not use the loudspeaker except for half an hour when the prize distribution ceremony will be performed. He has also stated that the prize distribution ceremony will be performed from 3:00 PM to 3:30 PM. The SDM and SHO have assured the Court that they would allow the petitioners to use the loudspeaker within 3:00 PM to 3:30 PM only when they will perform the ceremony of prize distribution. The SDM and SHO are also directed to maintain law and order at that time.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
