The petitioners pray for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the Collector, Land Acquisition (Consolidation), Chandigarh (respondent No.2), to issue Form No.16 with respect to tax deducted by the respondents-authorities from the compensation paid to the petitioners on account of compulsory acquisition of their land.

Counsel for the respondents states that in case the petitioners provide their PAN numbers, requisite Form No.16 will be issued to the petitioners expeditiously.

In view of statement made by counsel for the respondents, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly with a direction to the Collector, Land Acquisition (Consolidation), Chandigarh (respondent No.2), to issue Form No.16 within one month of the petitioners' filing their PAN numbers.
