The petitioner, claiming herself to be 1984 riot victim and alleged to have been issued Red Card by the State of Punjab, has filed this petition seeking direction to the respondents to allot flat to her as per the policy of allotment of houses/booths to the Sikh riot affected families, as applicable in her case.

It is the case of the petitioner that when the Greater Ludhiana Area Development Authority (GLADA) – respondent No.3 issued an advertisement for allotment of flats to the 1984 riot victims under the policy of the State Government, she also applied for allotment of flat. Accordingly, her name was put in the draw of lots for allotment of flats to the 1984 riot

victims. Unfortunately, the petitioner could not succeed in the said draw of lots.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, we dispose of this petition with liberty to the petitioner to submit a representation to GLADA – respondent No.3 for the relief sought in this petition. If any such representation is submitted by the petitioner, GLADA – respondent No.3 is directed to consider the claim of the petitioner by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months.
