Petitioner has filed this petition seeking writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to correct his date of birth in the 10th class certificate issued by the Punjab School Education Board.

Although the pleadings are complete, but learned Senior counsel appearing for respondent No.2 has stated at the bar that the application of the petitioner would be considered in terms of the notification dated 25.03.2015. The last date under the said notification for applying is 08.05.2015. It is further submitted by him that in case the petitioner takes this opportunity of filing the application before the cut-off-date, his application would be considered expeditiously and would be decided within two weeks.

This statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.2 satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner, who has submitted that petitioner would submit the application to the Chairman of the Punjab School Education Board before the cut-off-date alongwith fee/late fee and other necessary documents as per the proforma.

In case, such an application is filed before the cut-off-date i.e. 08.05.2015, the respondent No.2 shall decide the same as early as possible, preferably within a period of two weeks.

In view of the above, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
