The petitioner has approached this Court for quashing of show cause notice dated 11.9.2014, whereby the respondents have raised a demand of Rs.63,21,112/- as licence fee for the months of April to August, 2014.

Counsel for the respondents points that as final order dated 29.9.2014 (Annexure R-11) has been passed, the petitioner would be required to challenge this order.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner prays that the writ petition may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to seek his remedy in accordance with law.

We have heard counsel for the parties and perused averments in the writ petition as well as in the reply and as the respondents have passed final order dated 29.9.2014 (Annexure R-11), the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and

is, consequently, disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to seek his remedy in accordance with law.
