Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing order dated 22.09.2009 (Annexure P/1) passed by Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Gurdaspur, order dated 30.09.2010 (Annexure P/2) passed by the Collector, Gurdaspur and order dated 27.01.2014 (Annexure P/3) passed by the Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that against order dated 30.09.2010, revision petition was filed, which is now fixed for 01.10.2015 before the Financial Commissioner. Learned counsel

Further contends that against the same order dated 30.09.2010, another

revision petition has been filed by co-sharers Jaspal Singh and others, in which date has been given as 04.12.2015. He further contends that parties are the same in the subsequent petition.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. S.S. Chandumajra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent no.1 – Financial Commissioner that both the revision petitions be heard together by the same date and revision petition filed by Jaspal Singh and others should be pre-poned and fixed for 01.10.2015. The petitioners will be at liberty to obtain the summons dasti for effecting service upon the respondents in the revision petition.
