Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Senior DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and on instructions from Sh. D.S. Dhanda, Assistant Director, Department of Elementary Education, Haryana, states that if the petitioner appears before the Secretary Board of School Education, Haryana at Bhiwani on Tuesday the 29th of September, 2015 at 11.00 a.m. and voluntarily gives his sample thumb impressions, the same would be sent to the Forensic Science Laboratory, Madhuban, for examination to ascertain whether the petitioner while appearing in the HTET examination had indulged in impersonation and fraud and only after the report is received from the Forensic Science Laboratory, Madhuban, the matter would be considered whether the the petitioner needs to be criminally prosecuted or not. As a necessary corollary, it is stated that the FIR against the petitioner during the interregnum would be held in abeyance.

While accepting the statement made on behalf of the State of Haryana, counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would appear before the Secretary Board of School Education, Haryana at Bhiwani on Tuesday the 29th of September, 2015 at 11.00 a.m. to give his sample thumb impressions which may be sent for examination to the Forensic Science Laboratory, Madhuban.

In view of the above statement made on behalf of the State of Haryana, counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
