The precise grievance of the petitioners in this writ petition is against the alleged inaction of the Consolidation Authorities in taking follow-up steps after the order dated 23.01.2014 [P-5] was passed.

There is nothing on record to suggest that the petitioners ever approached the Consolidation Officer and/or any superior Statutory Authority with whom powers are vested under the East Punjab Holdings [Consolidation and Prevention of Fragmentation] Act, 1948. We have no reason to doubt that no sooner the petitioners would approach the appropriate forum, needful shall be done in accordance with law.

With liberty aforementioned, this writ petition is dismissed.
