Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that in an appeal against the order passed by the Estate Officer in terms of the Chandigarh Estate Rules, 2007, the petitioners have been given time to remove the violations within 90 days. Such 90 days are expiring on 10.02.2015, whereas the petitioners require still more time i.e. upto 10.04.2015 to remove the violations.

The grievance of the petitioners is that an application for extension of time is not being entertained by the Chief Administrator, therefore, this Court should extend the time for removal of the violations.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, we find that the petitioners have an efficacious alternative remedy of revision before the Adviser to the Administrator. In view of the said fact, we do not wish to entertain the present writ petition seeking extension of time for removal of the violations.

Consequently, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternative remedy as is available to them in accordance with law.
