Reply filed on behalf of respondents No. 4 to 7 is taken on record, copy supplied to the counsel for the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the writ petition qua petitioner No. 1, namely, Jarmaljit Singh son of Darshan Singh has been rendered infructuous as he has got migration to some other college and, therefore, does not want to pursue the writ petition any further.

Writ petition qua petitioner No. 1 is, therefore, disposed of as not pressed.

Counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the writ petition qua petitioner No. 2, namely, Arminderjit Singh son of Paramjit Singh, with liberty to avail of his alternative remedy in accordance with law including suit for damages and compensation against the respondents for having wasted his one year of studies which he had spent with the respondent No. 6-college.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No. 2 with liberty aforesaid.
