Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing impugned order dated 16.03.2015 (Annexure P/3) passed by respondent no.4 – Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utilities Services), Union Territory Chandigarh, whereby application filed by the petitioner for allotment of alternate site under the “Small Flats Scheme of 2006” has been declined.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

The finding recorded is that the name of the applicant-

petitioner does not exist in the family details of Smt. Basmati wife of Sh.

Vish Nath. Otherwise also, biometric survey was conducted and the name of the petitioner also does not figure in the same. After considering the facts on record, the finding has been recorded by respondent no.4 and this Court cannot be appreciated the finding of fact in exercise of the writ jurisdiction.

In view of above, instant writ petition is dismissed. However, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail other remedies available to him in accordance with law.
