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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner is working in Improvement Trust Jind since the year 1975 and he was promoted to the post of Secretary in the month of September 2010 in the grade pay of Rs.4200/-.

The petitioner is aggrieved of the condition imposed through letter dated 19.02.2014 (Annexure P-2), whereby, the interim relief of Rs.2000/- per month would be available only to group 'C' and 'D' employees of Municipal Corporations/Councils/ Committees Improvement Trusts who are having grade pay of Rs.4000/- per month or below.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no such condition has been imposed while granting interim relief to the State Government Employees. He further states that at all times, the employees of the Improvement Trust have enjoyed the pay scales and allowances at par with the employees of

the State Government. He submits that the Haryana Improvement Trust Employees Union(Regd.) has already submitted representation dated 31.07.2014(Annexure P-5) raising their grievance with regard to the conditions imposed in Annexure P-2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 31.7.2014(Annexure P-5).

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and take a decision on the representation dated 31.7.2014 (Annexure P-5) expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
