Though we would have relegated the petitioners to the alternative remedy in view of Article 243(O)(b) of the Constitution as election process for the Gram Panchayats election in Haryana stood notified on 08.09.2015. However, we are informed that keeping in view the subsequent developments, the State Government has decided to postpone the elections. The grievance of the petitioners against the voter list can thus be looked into meanwhile by the Sub Divisional Magistrate (Civil), Shahabad Markanda, District Kurukshetra.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of without expressing any views on merits with a direction to the said Authority to consider the petitioners' grievance and decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of one week from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
