Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, is for setting aside the order dated 23.09.2014 (Annexure P-4) and for issuance of direction to the respondents to pay the all pensionary/retiral benefits along with 18% per annum interest.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that entire amount has been received by him. However, he states that no amount has been paid towards interest on the delayed payment.

Keeping in view the fact that the entire amount stands paid,

the present petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to make a representation regarding interest on the delayed payment and respondents shall consider the same in the accordance with law and pass a speaking order within 4 months after receipt of such representation.
