Prayer in the present writ petition is for setting aside the order dated 10.08.2015 (Annexure P21) and a further direction to give her admission in M.Sc. Course on account of having won prizes and gold medals in sports.

It is the case of the petitioner that on account of taking part in the extra-curricular activities and being a part of the contingent of the Republic Day parade, she got a compartment in Maths subject in the 6th semester in the B.Sc. (Non-medical). She had applied for admission in M.Sc. and also in the meantime, applied for rechecking on account of not having passed the said subject. She was not granted admission, in view of the rules, which provided that the student should not have compartment and she was held not entitled for admission.

However, it is a matter of fact that the rechecking had been delayed and now, an affidavit has been filed on 22.12.2015 that she has secured 319 marks out of total 550 marks and a pass provisional slip has been issued to her on 21.12.2015. The same has been handed over to counsel for the petitioner.

This delay has, thus, led in lapse of crucial period and the petitioner's right for admission has been prejudiciously affected. It is also to be noted that respondent No.3-College had recommended her name for admission, on the strength of her achievements vide letter dated 05.08.2015.

In such circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that it would be appropriate that the respondent-University permits the petitioner to take admission in the above-said course, so that the right of the petitioner is not lost. The respondent-University and the College shall make appropriate arrangements so that the petitioner could attend her 1st semester classes and give examinations, subsequently, with the batch after she passes out from the 4th semester.

With the above-said observations, the present writ petition stands allowed.
