Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner raised in representation dated 16.09.2015 (Annexure P-2) and to ensure that he is able to do the work without any hindrance and illegal threats at the hands of respondent No.7.
