Mr. Mann submits that the matter has been rendered infructuous for the reason that the prayer of the petitioner was for appointment to the post of Block Extension Educator on the ground that he had secured more marks than the candidate whose name is under consideration for appointment. The petitioner secured 43.35 marks whereas the candidate on the list who had secured only 40.59 marks.

Learned State counsel has filed short affidavit of the Director Health Services (Family Welfare) Punjab, Chandigarh in Court today, which is taken on record wherein it is stated that the case of the petitioner has been reconsidered and an appointment letter dated 09.07.2014 has already been issued to him and he has already joined the post and his duty on 14.07.2014.

This renders the writ petition infructuous.

However, in case the petitioner has any other subsisting grievance, he may bring it to the notice of the Department which would consider his request and pass speaking orders, if required.

The petition stands disposed of as above.
