By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for setting aside the impugned order dated 10.10.2012 (Annexure P-7), passed by respondent No.3, whereby an amount of Rs. 276867/- was not allowed to the petitioner towards the expenses incurred on the treatment of her husband.

The learned counsel for the petitioner admits the factum of acceptance of Rs. 2,75,000/- towards the reimbursement of medical bills, however, at this stage, it is submitted that no amount on the delayed payment has been made to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the main grievance of the petitioner stands redressed and the entire amount stands paid, the

present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation within 45 days from today before the competent authority with regard to the claim of interest on the delayed payment in view of the order dated 01.06.2012 (Annexure P-6) and the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.3, is directed to pass an appropriate order, considering the order dated 01.06.2012 (Annexure P-6), within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
