RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

The record has been produced by Mr.Harkesh Manuja in original. He submits that twice over on 7.5.2013 and 5.9.2013, the petitioner had declined extension in service by exercising option not once but twice over and thereafter he has filed this petition claiming extension in service without disclosing the material fact that he had opted out of extension.

In view of this, the petitioner has tried to deflect the course of justice and has attempted to obtain orders by suppression by facts.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed with costs of ₹ 10,000/- to be paid to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre annexed to this Court. The payment be made within two months, failing which, this order will be executable by the Mediation & Conciliation Centre in accordance with law.
