The petitioner has filed a complaint dated 10.07.2015 to respondents No.2 to 5 regarding the alleged illegal construction by his neighbors, namely, respondents No.6 & 7 upon the adjoining plot. The petitioner *inter alia* contend that the private respondents have installed a service station with diesel engine generated etc. There has been no reply to the same till date.

2. The petition is disposed of by directing respondents No.2 to 5 to consider the petitioner's complaint and to take the necessary steps in accordance with law, if necessary. In the event of the official respondents being of the opinion that the construction is not illegal, they shall inform the petitioner in writing the reasons for the decision.

The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

The official respondents shall consider the petitioner's complaint within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
