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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner while working on the post of Accountant with respondent No.3 retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 28.02.2015.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the retiral benefits of the petitioner have not been released by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no justification with the respondents for not releasing the entire retiral benefits. He states that the petitioner submitted representations (Annexures P-3 and P-4) and also sent legal notice (Annexure P-5) to the respondents, but no action has been taken thereon so far.

He states that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the legal notice (Annexure P-5).

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and take a decision on the legal notice dated 01.09.2015 (Annexure P-5) , expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
