The relief sought in the present writ petition is for declaration of the result of the Teacher Eligibility Test (T.E.T.) in respect of the petitioner held in the year 2011

It is averred that despite submission of numerous representations, Annexures P/7 and P/8, relief has not been granted. The petitioner belongs to SC category as she is Balmiki by caste as per Annexure P/1. In the written statement, objection taken was that Roll no. and category under which the petitioner had applied had not been mentioned and for declaration of the result same was required.

Vide order dated 14.5.2015, the case was adjourned sine die as the petitioner could not give the detail on the ground that Roll no. has been lost. Now an affidavit has been filed by the counsel for the petitioner whereby Roll no. of the petitioner has been given as 10072364.

Keeping in view the details now submitted, it is directed that respondent no.2 shall ensure that the result of the T.E.T examination in respect of the petitioner held in 2011 is declared. The same be intimated to

the her within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
