The claim in the present writ petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the deducted amount of ₹ 92,585/- from the gratuity of the petitioner.

In the written statement filed on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3, it has been averred that the deducted amount has now been paid to the petitioner and the receipt has been attached as Annexure R/1 wherein a sum of ₹ 92,585/- has been received by her vide cheque No.000923 dated 13.12.2014.

Accordingly, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous since the relief claimed has been granted and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
