HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioners are working as Laboratory Assistant with respondent No.2-Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma, University of Health Science. Their grievance is that for promotion to the post Laboratory Technician five years' service experience as Laboratory Assistant and Diploma of Laboratory Technician are required. The petitioners are aggrieved of the fact that there is no quota for promotion to the post of Laboratory Technician based only on seniority-cum-fitness from amongst those Laboratory Attendants, who have completed decades of service, but do not have the diploma of Laboratory Technician, hence, they deprived of the promotional avenues.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in All India Institute of Medical Sciences, certain quota for promotion to the posts of Laboratory Technician has been given to such Laboratory Attendants . The petitioners have repeatedly represented to the respondents to look into their grievances but no action has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on their claim as contained in their representation dated 27.09.2011 (Annexure P-7).

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the claim of the petitioners as contained in their representation dated 27.09.2011 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law expeditiously.
