Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 20.12.2013 (Annexure P/4) passed by respondent no.2, whereby revision petition filed by the petitioner against order dated 15.06.2009 (Annexure P/3) passed by respondent no.3, has been dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon notification dated 20.11.1980 (Annexure P/1) whereby powers under the relevant

Punjab New Mandi Township Act, 1960, have been ordered to cease to operate in such areas of the New Mandi Townships as are mentioned in the Schedule in which khasra numbers have been mentioned. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of this notification (Annexure P/1).

I am of the view that the notification (Annexure P/1) is only with respect to the property belonging to the New Mandi Township and is not applicable to the godown of the petitioner.

In view of above, I do not find any illegality or perversity in the impugned order.

Dismissed in limine.
