Petitioner, herein, earlier filed CWP No.20677 of 2010. The said writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the learned Deputy Commissioner, Gurgaon to consider and dispose of the representation of the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy by him. The said representation has since been decided vide order, Annexure R-1 and the decision thereon was communicated to the petitioner vide order dated April 28, 2011, Annexure R-2.

Petitioner has now filed this writ petition seeking a direction to reframe the Municipal Wards strictly in accordance with the provisions of law and keeping in view the mandate of Article 243 T of the Constitution of India. This writ petition came up for motion hearing on October 17, 2011 and was ordered to be heard with CWP No.8381 of 2011.

CWP No.8381 of 2011 has since been disposed of vide order dated December 02, 2015 having been rendered infructuous by the Lok Adalat with liberty to the petitioner to get it revived in case of need.

It is worthwhile to mention here that elections to the Municipal Council have already taken place which renders the present writ petition infructuous and it is, accordingly, dismissed as such. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to get it revived in case of need as learned counsel for the petitioner has not put in appearance.
