This Civil Writ Petition has been filed, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of direction to the respondents to pay the revised pension/pensionary benefits, revised gratuity, leave encashment and interest on the payment of GP fund from the period 01.12.2009 till date along with interest @18% per annum.

At the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by judgment of this in case **Gurbachan Singh Vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala**, rendered in CWP No.3312 of 2013, decided on 11.05.2015.

The learned counsel for the respondents does not controvert

the assertion raised by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The respondent-Corporation is directed to release the entire retiral dues to the petitioner within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that in case, the payment is not made within the stipulated period, the present petition shall be deemed to have been revived, without notice
