Vide work order dated 26.11.2010 (Annexure P-1), the petitioner was allotted the works of Arch Bridge Nos.239 and 176 with RCC Box on JUC-FZR Section under ADEN/II/FZR.

It is contended that though the entire work of Bridge No.176 has been completed, but still an amount of Rs.2,06,000/- (Two lacs, six thousand rupees) for the work done is due from the respondents, which is not being paid despite repeated requests to them.

Learned counsel states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to take a decision on its claim as contained in the legal notice dated 09.06.2015 (Annexure P-4).

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as contained in the legal notice dated 09.06.2015 (Annexure P-4) and take a decision thereon in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
