Vide work order No.42 to 45 dated 28.02.2014, the petitioner was allotted the work of re-construction of V.R. Bridge at RD 22933 of 6-R Disty.

It is contended that though the entire work assigned to the petitioner has been completed, but still an amount of Rs.1,43,635/- (One lac fourty three thousand six hundred five) is due from the respondents, which is not being paid despite repeated requests to the respondent – authorities.

Learned counsel states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to take a decision on its claim as contained in the legal notice dated 03.06.2015 (Annexure P-2).

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as contained in the legal notice dated 03.06.2015 (Annexure P-2) and take a decision thereon in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
