G.S.SANDHAWALIA, J. (Oral)

The petitioner claims a right of seniority in the joint seniority list of Junior Scale Stenographers/Steno-typists and Clerks and consideration for promotion to the post of Senior Assistant from the date her juniors were given promotion with all consequential benefits including the re-fixation of her pay and pensionary benefits since she stands retired with effect from 31.8.2012.

It is not disputed that the petitioner has submitted representation dated 14.8.2015 (Annexure P/14) to respondent no.2 for the necessary relief.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.2 to decide the said representation within some time frame.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed off without calling the respondents to file their reply.

Accordingly, without going into merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the representation has been filed on 14.8.2015 (Annexure P/14) which is still pending, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take into consideration the said representation and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. It is made clear that nothing said herein shall prejudice the said respondent who has to take decision in accordance with law. **Needless**

to say, in case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the said respondent

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
