AJAY KUMAR MITTAL J.(Oral)

This is a writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release goods without insisting for cash deposit of ₹ 2,29,831/- by Manual TR-6 Challan and further directing the respondent No.3 to make final assessment or in alternative release the goods in terms of Customs (Provisional Duty Assessment) Regulations, 2011.

2. It is not disputed that during the pendency of the writ petition certain adverse orders against the petitioner have been passed by the respondent-authorities. It was urged by learned counsel for the petitioner that in such circumstances he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh writ petition by impugning the said orders.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It shall, however be, open to the petitioner to file fresh writ petition or to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it in accordance with law.
