Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing notice dated 18.08.2015 (Annexure P/4) issued by respondent no.3, vide which petitioner no.1 has been directed to vacate the land situated at Village Mandi Killianwali, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

In this petition, petitioners have only challenged notice dated 18.08.2015 (Annexure P/4) issued to petitioner no.1. There is no dispute that petitioners can only be evicted in accordance with law. It is settled principle of law that no-one can be thrown away illegally or arbitrarily except in due course of law. Perusal of paper-book indicates

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that instant writ petition is pre-mature.

In view of above, instant petition is dismissed as pre-mature.
