Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the payment of duly sanctioned bills along with 18% interest from the date of sanctioning of the bills till its payment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that direction may be issued to respondent no.4 – Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitation, Division No.2, Bathinda, to pass an appropriate order on his letter dated 22.06.2015 (Annexure P/6). Learned counsel further submits that instant writ petition may also be treated as a representation in

addition to Annexure P/6.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.4 – Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitation, Division No.2, Bathinda, to consider the letter (Annexure P/6) and pass an appropriate order thereon in accordance with law. The petitioner will be at liberty to submit a fresh representation. Needful shall be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order copy of the order so passed shall be communicated forthwith to the petitioner.
