LISA GILL, J.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to typographical error in the memo of parties, respondent No. 4 has been mentioned as Municipal Council, Fazilka though it should read as Municipal Council, Abohar.

On oral request of learned counsel, it is directed that necessary correction be carried out in the memo of parties. Municipal Council, Fazilka should read as Municipal Council, Abohar.

Prayer in this writ petition is for release of remaining service benefits due to the petitioner such as Ex-gratia grant, Gratuity, leave encashment, balance of revised pay scale etc. It is submitted that numerous representations, last one being, Annexure P-4, dated 07.07.2014, have been submitted by the petitioner but no action has been taken thereon. It is prayed that the said representation be directed to be decided.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments and the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the respondent No. 4 to expeditiously decide representation dated 07.07.2014 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
