HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The husband of the petitioner, who was working as Constable in the Indo-Tibetan Board Police, was dismissed from service on 18.05.1995 . After dismissal from service, the husband of the petitioner had filed statutory appeal to the Deputy Inspector General, Indo-Tibetan Boarder Police-respondent No.3, which was received in his office dated 11.01.1996. This appeal was filed against order No.1188, dated 18.05.1995 passed by the Commandant, 5th Bn. ITBP, dismissing him from service w.e.f. 18.05.1995. The husband of the petitioner during life time submitted various notices dated 31.01.2007 application dated 24.12.2012 and thereafter, reminders of the application dated 07.03.2013, 30.09.2014, 26.05.2014 and 30.04.2015 but to no avail.

The only grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent No.3 be directed to take a decision on the statutory appeal of the petitioner expeditiously.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the statutory appeal filed by the husband of the petitioner expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
